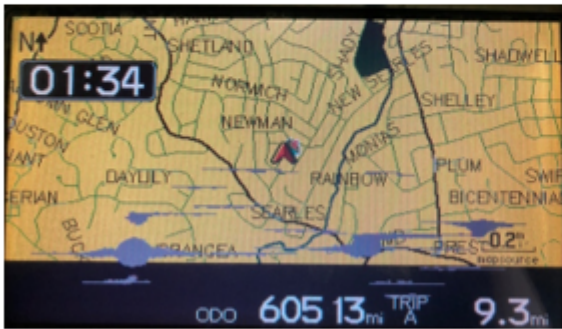
Lakeside Lanes is a Candle Pin bowling alley. Hope to see you there.

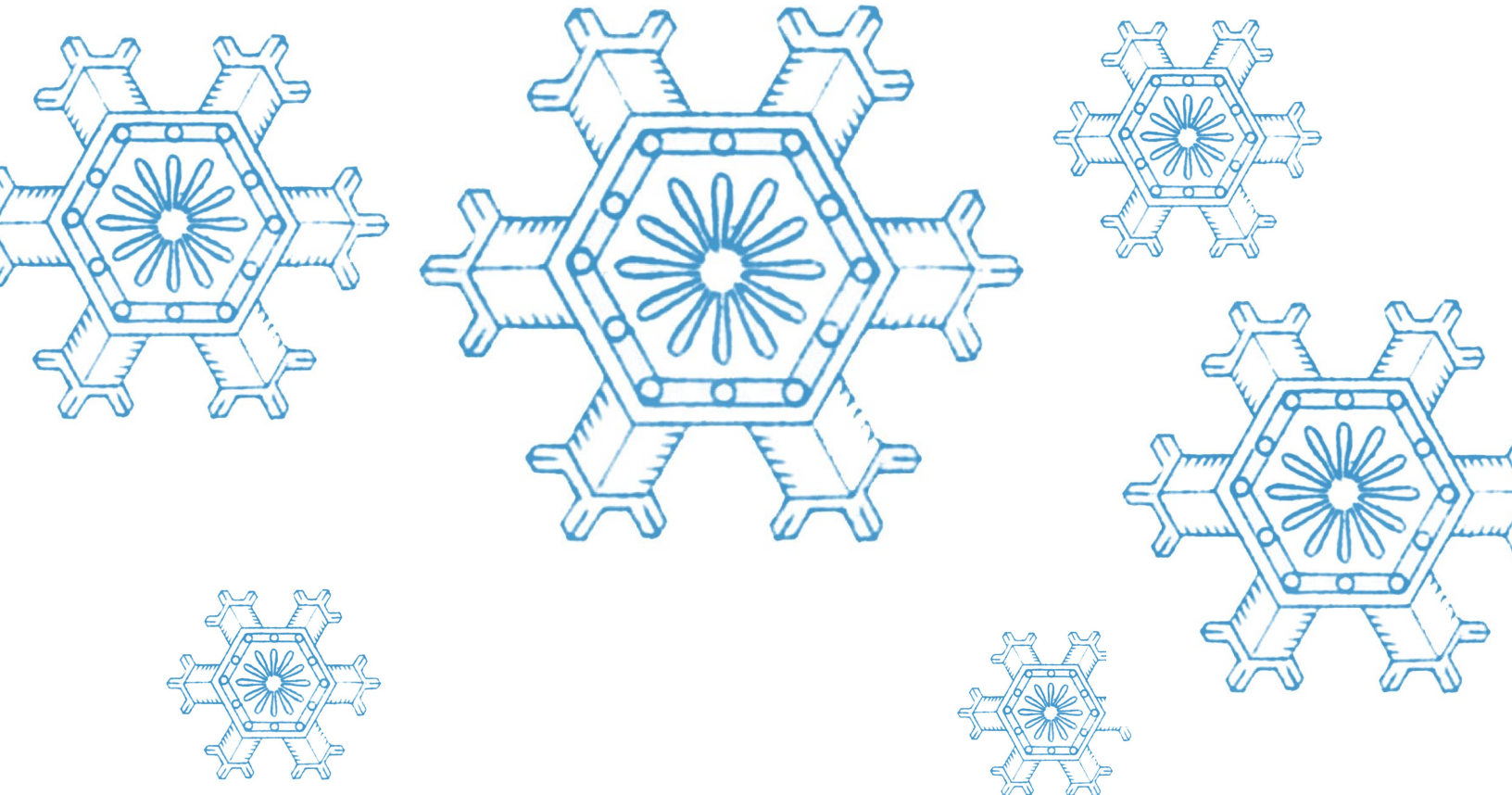

Rider Education

The core reason for the Rider Education program is knowledge and the ability to operate a motorcycle safely, in all conditions.

Rider Education is acquiring safe riding skills and knowledge. Motorcycle riding is 38 times more dangerous than traveling by car, truck, airplane or rail. Rider Education can't make riding safe compared to other types of travel, but we can do things to make riding less dangerous. Whether we acquire our safe riding knowledge from GWRRA or other seminars and courses, or through independent study - we can reduce the risk of riding by learning, relearning and practicing.

Riding Skills – learn, relearn, practice:

- Slow Ride – Friction Zone
- Turning from a Stop
- Quick Stop, Hard Braking
- Weaves – Counter Steering
- U-Turns, Fig 8's, Tight Circles
- Hi-Speed Swerves,
- Brake & Evade

Safe Riding Topics:

- Riding Readiness
- Distracted Drivers
- Riding in the Heat (or Cold)
- Riding at Night (or in Rain)
- How Aging Affects Riders
- Trailering
- Team Riding

Level I of the Rider Education Program is called Safety by Commitment, or Safe Miles. Level I can be obtained by simply committing to riding safely and accident free. This includes a promise to learn for the sake of Rider, Co-Rider, friends, family, and others on the road.

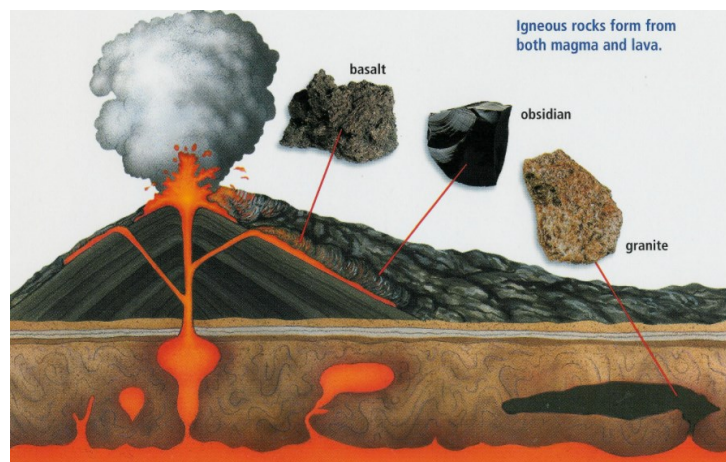
